Howeless: For the months of June, July & August, MM prepared Summer Snack Bags, (12 for each month) including bottled water, rain poncho, healthy snacks, sun screen, wet wipes, suckers & electrolyte powder, along with 2 \$5 McDonald's gift cards. Volunteers helped to fill the bags.

Veterows: Greater Green Bay Community Foundation will not announce the grants until September. Mary's Missions has proposed a grant to make "Kitchen Kits" to help veterans transitioning to independent living.

Native American women & children: Shipments of children's clothing, toys and educational materials were shipped on June 1 consisting of 3 boxes. On August 1, 5 boxes were sent and contained fall jackets & sweaters, and lots of school supplies. Wild Horse Butte Community Development Center is holding a "Back to School Bash" and Mary's Missions is playing a large part in this event. Next will be a shipment of toys and warm winter clothing which will ship about the end of November or very early December.
